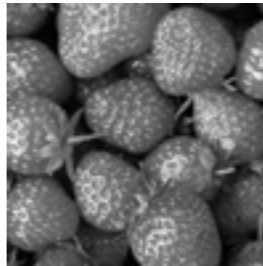

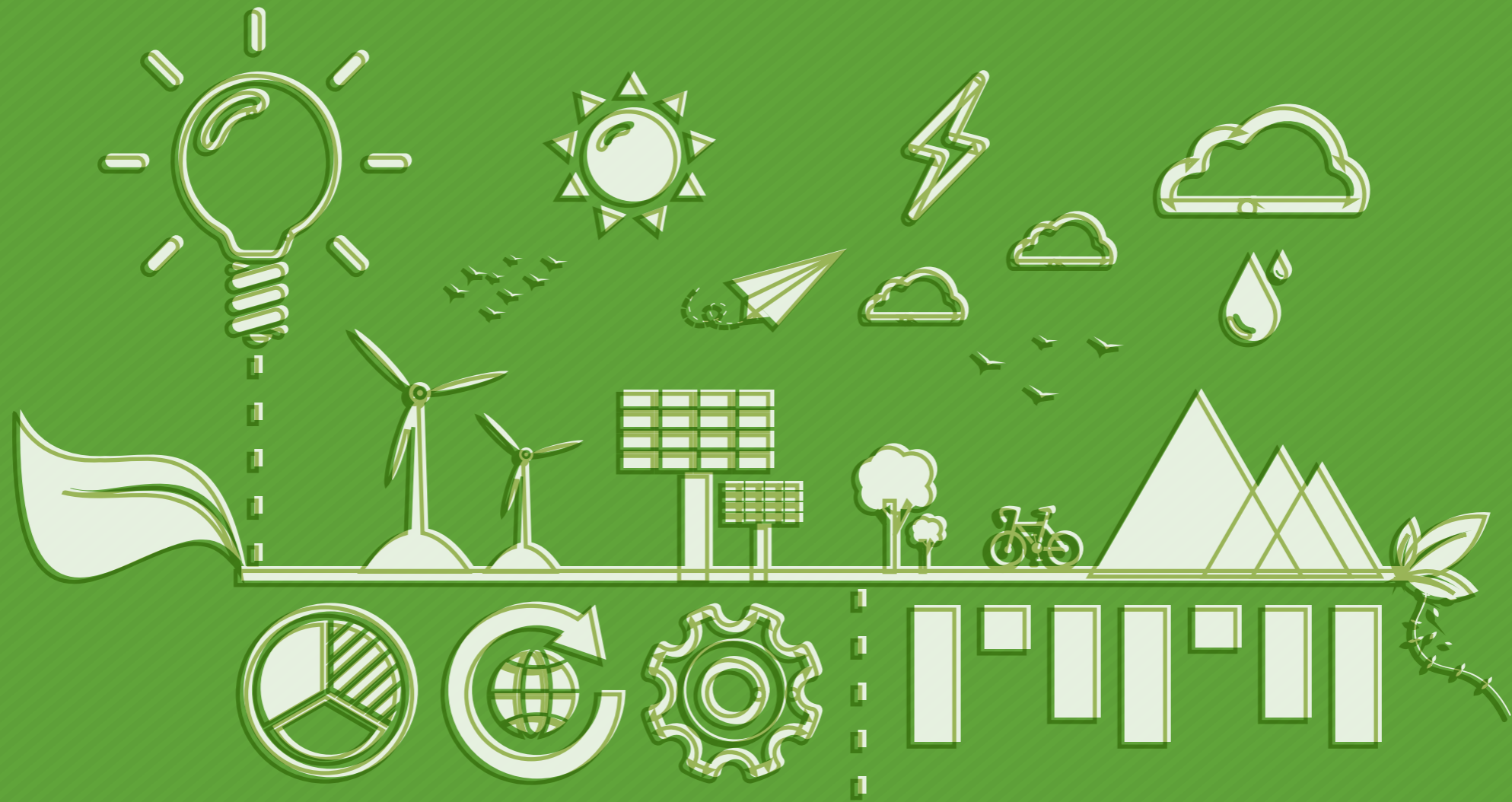

1. Carbon Footprint

- Voluntary reporting to the Israeli Ministry of Environmental Protection and report verification by the Israeli Standards Institute (ISO 14064 - Greenhouse Gas Accounting and Verification)
- Implementation of a program to reduce emissions in our Amiad & Beit Zera sites. The program includes:
 - Energy efficiency
 - Reducing fuel consumption
 - Program to reduce the damaging gas consumption of old air conditioners



2. Recycling centers, waste separation and recycling tanks at both Israeli sites:

- Plastic
- Wooden pallets
- Paper and carton
- Nylon
- Metal & electronic waste
- Hazardous waste



3. Water Conservation

- All of our filtration system testing labs at our Israeli sites use recycled water
- The water is monitored & maintained and inspected regularly

4. Additional Positive Aspects

- Amiad HQ recently began using 100% recycled paper in all copy machines
- Conveying environmental requirements to our main subcontractors and assisting them with implementation



5. Conflict Minerals Management

are natural resources extracted in a conflict zone and sold to perpetuate violence. The most commonly mined are tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold (known as 3TGs), which are extracted from the Eastern Congo.

Amiad promotes awareness activities related to Conflict Minerals among its employees and relevant direct suppliers, thus advancing the implementation of the international framework for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals.

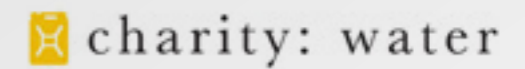

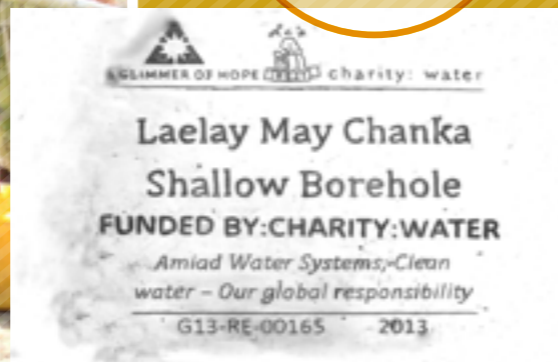


Amiad & charity: water

After establishing two drinking water systems in Ethiopia and India, Amiad Water Systems continues this tradition with a third one in Uganda.

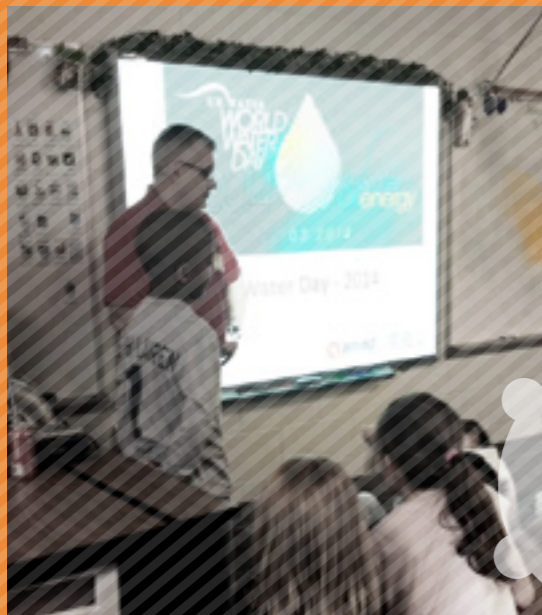


Amiad & World Water Day

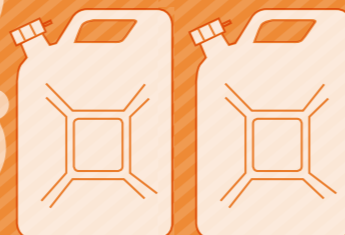
